

Thank you for proceeding to the hearing, I hope my contribution will be helpful.

I moved to Israel 2 years ago and for the second year I have to file my taxes for the US.

I have 2 criticisms regarding this:

1/ Why should I still pay for American issues when I'm not even represented in the Congress/ Senate?  
There should be either a representation, or no taxes. I feel I'm just the tax payer with no benefit and my voice cannot be heard. I don't have a legal representative. I read everywhere most countries in the world (if not all) do not tax their citizens.

2/ One of my child has a SSN, the other one does not (one was born in the US, the other was born in a foreign country, but has US citizenship). It is unjust I can tax- deduct my child with SSN and not my child without one. My second child is a dependent and the fact that she doesn't have any SSN should not make it a condition for tax deduction. I can still prove her existence (passport, birth certificate). She doesn't need to have an SSN to be a proven American; this is unfair for my tax deductions as it doesn't account for half of my family that I provide for.
