When you click to view a form from that website, the display gives an ad for Tax Act (another Free File alliance customer) that says everyone can efile for free (however Tax Act has restrictions).

Many of these states have free internet filing. • Consult a tax professional - \$6.95 per question – does this include follow up questions? • Tax tips section discusses two items – the first is education credit / tuition and fees deduction and the other is the advance child tax credit (a 2003 tax issue). The education credit / tuition and fees deduction lists the deduction amount as \$3,000 [the 2005 tuition and fees deduction is \$4,000 \$2,000, or \$0 depending on AGI]. The text is also unclear in that it says “Form 8863, Lifetime Learning Credit has been increased to \$10,000” instead of saying that the maximum amount of qualified expenses that can be taken into account for the credit is \$10,000 (the credit is limited to \$2,000/\$4,000 for education in the Gulf Opportunity Zone). The second item states “In the personal information section you will input the amount of Advanced Child Tax Credit you received. If your filing status in Tax Year 2002 was married filing jointly this amount may be one-half of the amount of the check deposited into your bank account....” This whole write-up is inapplicable to tax year 2005 (not to mention that it is poorly worded). • Prices and AGI requirements changed between 2/10/06 and 2/14/06. On 2/10, you could efile your fed return for free if your AGI was less than \$29,000 - otherwise it cost \$10.95 (now \$14.95) and extensions were \$3.95 (now free) • There also must have been an interim AGI level of \$33,000 or less, because on 2/27 the FAQ/Fees page originally said if your AGI is over \$33,001, it costs \$14.95 to efile fed return. Later that same day this page was updated to reflect AGI levels between \$10,000 and \$50,000. The IRS summary page shows that on 2/14 the AGI levels were between \$10,000 and \$50,000 – so when was it at the \$33,000 level – why was it still showing this level on 2/27? • The supported forms are W-2 / W-2G / 1099-G / 1099-INT / 1099-DIV / 1099-R / SSA-1099 / Sch A / B / EIC / 2106EZ / 2441 / 3903 / 4137 / 8812 / 8332 / 8863 / 8880 / 4868. Titles of forms are listed. However, there is also a list of limitations and unsupported items to supported forms. One of these limitations is Hurricane Katrina relief – what does this mean in terms of Schedule A and Form 8863? How will people know that they can elect to use prior years earned income – they can’t on this site – I don’t know how the other sites handle this. • Under “New Features” the website says that it now has support for people who were denied the EIC in a previous year, but the supported forms for tax year 2005 do not list Form 8862, Information to Claim Earned Income Credit After Disallowance.

Website (right above where it lists the forms supported) says you can have only income from wages, salary, or tips, interest income, unemployment, state or local income tax refunds, social security benefits and you would like to take the EIC – no mention of supporting credit for child and dependent care expenses, child tax credit, education credits, or credit for retirement savings contributions that are associated with Forms 2441/8812/8863/8880). • Although Sch B is listed as a supported form, the forms limitations link provides for “unsupported elements” such as the fact that the software does not support tax-exempt interest or the Sch B lines related to tax-exempt interest, the Sch B lines for nominee distributions, OID adjustments, accrued interest, etc. • More importantly, the software assumes that the answer to the foreign account question is No. If you are required to File Form 90-22.1 but do not do so, you may have to pay a penalty of up to \$10,000 (more in some cases) [American Jobs Creation Act of 2004, section 821, amending 31 USC 5321] • Only does a 1040 or 1040EZ – does not do a 1040A return – these filers presumably would file the longer form

H&R Block's Tax Cut
