IN RESPONSE TO SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 115 OF JANUARY 9, 1924, INFORMATION SHOWING THE AMOUNTS OF NET INCOME AND EXCESS PROFITS TAX, BY INDUSTRIAL DIVISIONS AND EXCESS-PROFITS TAX BRACKETS, REPORTED TO THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT IN THE CORPORATE INCOME AND EXCESS-PROFITS TAX RETURNS FOR 1921.

MARCH 15 (calendar day, MARCH 17), 1924.—Referred to the Committee on Finance and ordered to be printed.

The President pro tempore, United States Senate.

Sir: I have the honor to transmit herewith the data requested in Senate Resolution 115, which resolution reads as follows:

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and is hereby, requested to furnish to the Senate information regarding the excess-profits taxes of corporations based upon the business of 1921 and for which returns or assessments were made during the year 1922, as follows:

For each serial number of corporations as indicated on pages 58 to 65, inclusive, Table 9, "Statistics of income from returns of net income for 1921," as compiled and published under the direction of the Commissioner of Internal Revenue.

(a) The number of corporations in each serial number reporting income subject to taxation under the first bracket of the revenue act of 1921, together with the amount of net earnings subject to such tax and the amount of tax assessed thereon.

(b) The number of corporations in each serial number reporting income subject to taxation under the second bracket of said act, together with the amount of net earnings subject to such tax and the amount of tax assessed thereon.

The information contained in the attached compilation was prepared from the income and profits tax returns as filed by the corporations and before being audited by the department, and therefore prior to whatever revision may be made upon being audited.

# CORPORATE RETURNS AND EXCESS-PROFITS TAX FOR 1921.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES.

The tables submitted herein have followed the order prescribed in Senate Resolution 115. The numbers given the 165 industrial divisions correspond to the serial numbers in Table 9, pages 58-65, inclusive, "Statistics of income from the returns of net income for 1921."

The compilation is divided into two sets of tables, A and B. Tables  $\Lambda$ -(1-165) contain the data reported by 30,220 corporations whose accounting period, either on the calendar or fiscal year basis, ended in 1921. If on the fiscal-year basis, the year ended after June 30.

Tables B-(1-165) contain the data reported by 776 concerns, all of which reported on the fiscal-year basis, the accounting period ending prior to July 1, 1922. The excess-profits tax having been repealed as of January 1, 1922, the data contained in Table B are from the returns of corporations receiving part of the income in 1921 which was subject to the excess-profits tax and part in 1922 not subject to this tax.

The corporations tabulated in each of the industrial divisions are segregated in the following manner:

Concerns taxed under the first bracket only. Concerns taxed under the second bracket only.

Concerns taxed under both first and second brackets.

Concerns taxed under miscellaneous provisions.

Under each of these distributions the following information is shown:

Number of returns.

Total net income. Excess-profits credits.

Income taxed under the first bracket.

Income taxed under the second bracket.

Income taxed under miscellaneous provisions.

Total income subject to excess-profits tax.

Excess-profits tax under the first bracket. Excess-profits tax under the second bracket.

Excess-profits tax under miscellaneous provisions.

Total excess-profits tax.

Provisions of the war-profits and excess-profits tax for 1921 governing the segregation of the returns for the tabulation of the data in this resolution:

### SEGREGATION OF THE RETURNS IN THE TABLES.

#### [Revenue act of 1021-Part II. Imposition of the tax.]

SEC. 301 (a). That in lieu of the tax imposed by Title III of the revenue act of 1918, but in addition to the other taxes imposed by this act, there shall be levied, collected, and paid for the calendar year 1921 upon the net income of every corporation (except corporations taxable under subdivision (b) of this section) a tax equal to the sum of the following:

## CONCERNS TAXED UNDER FIRST BRACKET ONLY.

First bracket: 20 per centum of the amount of the net income in excess of the excess-profits credit (determined under section 312) and not in excess of 20 per centum of the invested capital.

#### CONCERNS TAXED UNDER SECOND BRACKET ONLY.

Second bracket: 40 per centum of the amount of the net income in excess of 20 per centum of the invested capital.

#### CONCERNS TAXED UNDER BOTH FIRST AND SECOND BRACKETS.

(c) In any case where the full amount of the excess-profits credit is not allowed under the first bracket of subdivision (a), by reason of the fact that such credit is in excess of 20 per centum of the invested capital, the part not so allowed shall be deducted from the amount in the second bracket.

#### CONCERNS TAXED UNDER MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

SEC. 302. That the tax imposed by subdivision (a) of section 301 shall in no case be more than 20 per centum of the amount of the net income in excess of \$3,000 and not in excess of \$20,000, plus 40 per centum of the amount of the net

income in excess of \$20,000; and

The limitations imposed by section 302 of the revenue act of 1918 (upon taxes computed under subdivision (c) of section 301 of that act) are hereby made applicable to taxes computed under subdivision (b) of section 301 of this act.

Nothing in this section shall be construed in such manner as to increase the

tax imposed by section 301 of this act.
Sec. 303. That if part of the net income of a corporation is derived (1) from a trade or business (or a branch of a trade or business) in which the employment trade or business (or a branch of a trade or business) in which the employment of capital is necessary, and (2) a part (constituting not less than 30 per centum of its total net income) is derived from a separate trade or business (or a distinctly separate branch of the trade or business) which if constituting the sole trade or business would bring it within the class of "personal service corporations," then (under regulations prescribed by the commissioner with the approval of the Secretary) the tax upon the first part of such net income shall be separately computed (allowing in such computation only the same proportionate part of the credits authorized in section 312), and the tax upon the second part shall be the same percentage thereof as the tax so computed upon the first part is of such first part:

Provided. That the tax upon such second part shall in no case be less than 20

Provided, That the tax upon such second part shall in no case be less than 20 per centum thereof, unless the tax upon the entire net income, if computed without benefit of this section, would constitute less than 20 per centum of such entire net income, in which event the tax shall be determined upon the entire net income, without reference to this section, as other taxes are determined under this

title.

The total tax computed under this section shall be subject to the limitations

provided in section 302.

SEC. 304 (c). In the case of any corporation engaged in the mining of gold, the portion of the net income derived from the mining of gold shall be exempt from the tax imposed by this title or any tax imposed by Title II of the revenue act of 1917, and

The tax on the remaining portion of the net income shall be the same proportion of a tax computed without the benefit of this subdivision which such remaining portion of the net income bears to the entire net income.

SEC. 337. That in the case of a bona fide sale of mines, oil or gas wells, or any

interest therein, where the principal value of the property has been demonstrated by prospecting or exploration and discovery work done by the taxpayer, the portion of the tax imposed by this title attributable to such sale shall not exceed 20 per centum of the selling price of such property or interest.

SEC. 301 (b). For the calendar year 1921, there shall be levied, collected, and paid upon the net income of every corporation which derives in such year a net income of more than \$10,000 from any Government contract or contracts made between April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, both dates inclusive, a tax equal to the sum of the following:

(1) Such a portion of a tax computed at the rates specified in subdivision (a) of section 301 of the revenue act of 1918, as the part of the net income attributable to such Government contract or contracts bears to the entire net income.

In computing such tax the excess-profits credit and the war-profits credit which would be applicable to such calendar year under the revenue act of 1918,

if it had been continued in force, shall be used;

(2) Such a portion of a tax computed at the rates specified in subdivision (a) of this section as the part of the net income not attributable to such Government contract or contracts bears to the entire net income.

For the purpose of determining the part of the net income attributable to such Government contract or contracts, the proper apportionment and allocation of the deductions with respect to gross income derived from such Government contract or contracts and from other sources, respectively, shall be determined under rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner with the approval of the Secretary.
