REPORT

The Committee on Finance, to whom was referred the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 288) entitled "Joint resolution to permit articles imported from foreign countries for the purpose of exhibition at the New York World's Fair, 1939, New York City, N. Y., to be admitted without payment of tariff, and for other purposes", having had the same under consideration, report favorably thereon without amendment and recommend that the joint resolution be passed.

The proposed legislation follows the usual form of resolutions heretofore passed by the Congress and approved by the President, permitting the importation of articles free of duty for the purposes of exhibition.
