Dear Senators Thune, Schumer, Crapo, and Wyden,

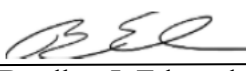
Having represented hundreds of Jeffrey Epstein's victims for decades, we write today on behalf of a group of survivors to voice support for the Produce Epstein Treasury Records Act (S. 2746). This legislation authored by Senator Wyden would require the Treasury Department to produce financial records related to Jeffrey Epstein to the U.S. Senate. These records are crucial to exposing how Epstein financed a cross-border criminal organization that abused countless women and girls.

For far too long Epstein and his co-conspirators have been able to hide in the shadows and conceal the vast amount of wealth that fueled his decades long sex trafficking operation. Consistently, the Epstein survivors have voiced the importance of transparency and championed the message that all records contained within the government's files must be produced and that includes these Treasury Department records. We urge the U.S. Senate to promptly pass S. 2746.
