## REPORT

[To accompany H. R. 3341]

The Committee on Finance, to whom was referred the bill (H. R 3341) to provide revenue by the taxation of certain nonintoxicating liquor, and for other purposes, having considered the same, report favorably thereon with a recommendation that the bill do pass with amendments.

The amendments include within the bill wines and fruit juices containing one-half of 1 per cent or more of alcohol by volume and not more than 3.2 per cent of alcohol by weight. The amendments are substantially in the same language as in the bill reported by the Finance and Judiciary Committees of the Senate in the last Congress, commonly known as the Blaine bill.
