REPORT.

[To accompany H. R. 6433.]

In view of the fact that nearly all the revenues derived from the customs district of Florida are paid by importing establishments located in Tampa, no substantial reason is perceived for locating the headquarters of the district elsewhere.

The committee, therefore, after hearings and due consideration, favorably report the bill H. R. 6433 to the Senate, and recommend its passage by that body.
