Res. 186) to provide transportation and travel subsistence to World War veterans temporarily quartered in the District of Columbia, having considered the same, report it to the Senate with the following amendments and recommend that it do pass.

Line 4, strike out the word "now".
Line 9, strike out "\$2" and insert "75 cents".
Line 14, after the word "hereby" insert the following: "authorized to be".
