

# TRUMP'S HEALTH CARE HIT LIST

March 2026

On July 4, 2025, congressional Republicans and Trump enacted the largest health care cuts in history, slashing over \$1 trillion from Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Already, hospitals and clinics are closing, workers are being laid off, patients are losing insurance coverage, and states are scrambling to fill budget gaps. New moms, kids, rural communities, people with disabilities, safety-net providers, and working families are feeling the strain. This digest summarizes the ongoing fallout and provides a conservative snapshot of immediate harms to communities nationwide.

## A CLOSER LOOK AT WHO'S PAYING THE PRICE

### [\\$22M in Cuts to Medicaid Disability Services for Idaho Residents](#)

**Where:** ID - Statewide

**Impact:** \$22M cut to disability services

**Why it matters:** The cuts reduce Medicaid rates for residential habilitation providers serving people with developmental disabilities. This raises concerns that providers may scale back services or close, reducing access to essential community-based care.

**Effective:** Fiscal Year 2027

### [Planned Parenthood Clinic Closure Reduces Access in Central Florida](#)

**Where:** Lakeland, FL - Planned Parenthood Lakeland Health Center

**Impact:** Clinic Closure

**Why it matters:** The clinic was the only Planned Parenthood in Polk County, so many Medicaid patients will lose access to birth control, cancer screenings, STI testing and treatment, and mental health care.

**Effective:** Mid-March 2026

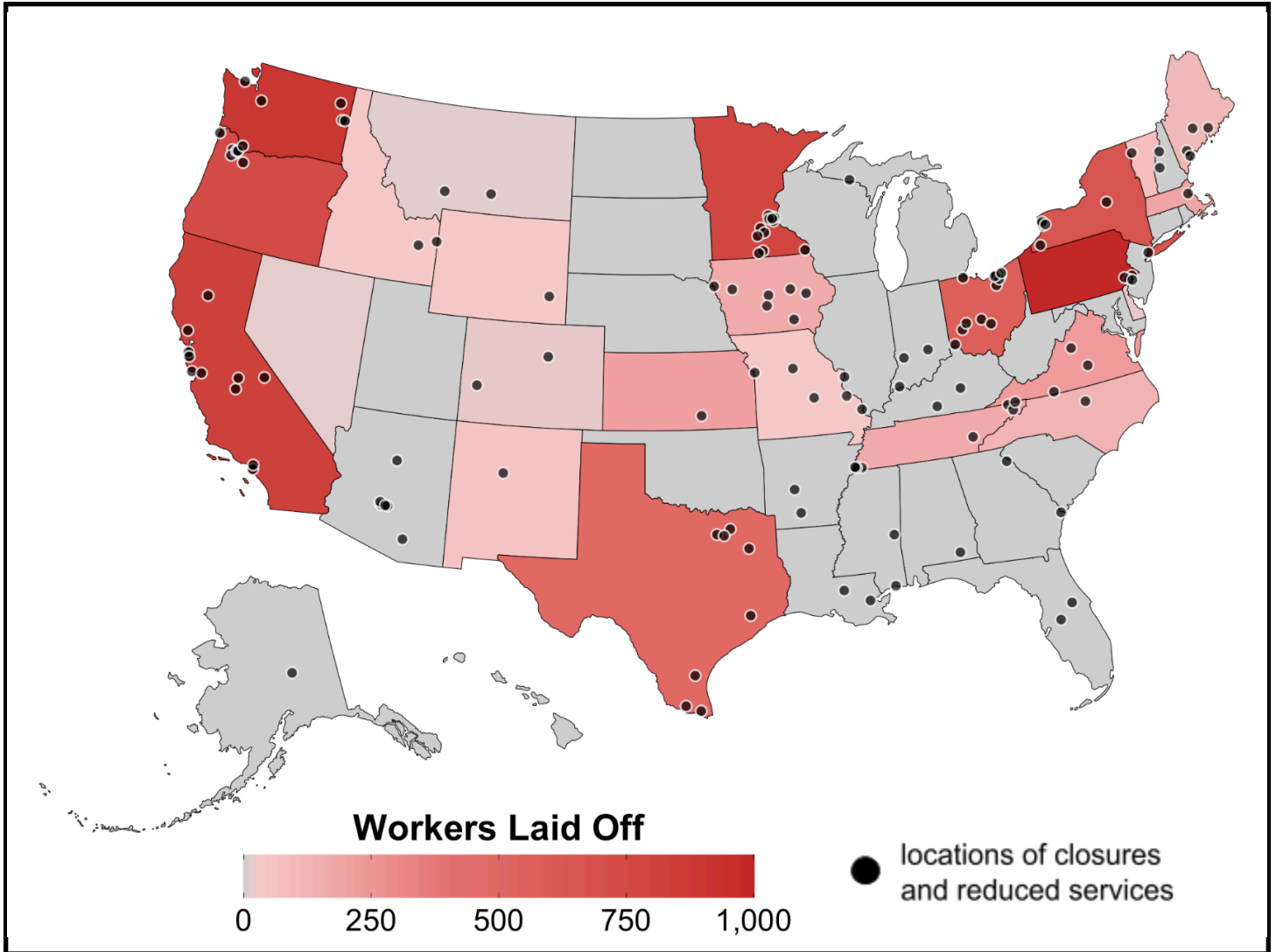
