Dear Director,

Pursuant to the Senate Finance Committee's oversight responsibilities over the Department of the Treasury and for financial crimes I am writing to request more information about reported alterations in the Suspicious Activity Report (SAR) database related to the Michael Cohen/Essential Consulting LLC accounts, including possible removal or sequestration of SARs reporting suspicious activity in these accounts.<sup>1</sup>

On May 16, 2018, The New Yorker reported that SARs related to Michael Cohen's accounts had been removed from the normally accessible SARs database.<sup>2</sup> According to a number of individuals with knowledge of the database cited in this report, as well as other reporting on these allegations, indicates that removal or sequestration of SARs is highly unusual if not unprecedented.

In addition to the request I made on May 11<sup>th</sup> for information related to payments received by Mr. Cohen, Essential Consultants LLC, and any related entities from Novartis International AG, I am requesting the following:

- 1) Copies of any documents in FinCEN's possession, including but not limited to any and all SARs, related to any payments made to Mr. Cohen, Essential Consultants or related entities.
- 2) Confirmation of whether or not, as alleged in the New Yorker article, SARs related to any such payments were removed or sequestered from within the SAR database.
- 3) If SARs were removed or sequestered, an explanation of why this was done and by whom.
- 4) Copies of all policies and guidelines related to management of the SARs database.
