

# TRUMP'S HEALTH CARE HIT LIST

June 2026

On July 4, 2025, congressional Republicans and Trump enacted the largest health care cuts in history, slashing over \$1 trillion from Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Already, hospitals and clinics are closing, workers are being laid off, patients are losing insurance coverage, and states are scrambling to fill budget gaps. New moms, kids, rural communities, people with disabilities, safety-net providers, and working families are feeling the strain. This digest summarizes the ongoing fallout and provides a conservative snapshot of immediate harms to communities nationwide.

## MOUNTING LOSSES: JUNE IN NUMBERS

## A CLOSER LOOK AT WHO'S PAYING THE PRICE

### [Aurora Mental Health Eliminating 111 Jobs](#)

**Where:** Aurora, Colorado — Aurora Mental Health & Recovery  
**Impact:** Eliminating 111 positions, roughly 14% of their workforce  
**Why it matters:** Safety net mental health and substance use disorder providers continue to face financial headwinds from Republicans' Big Ugly Bill. Even as demand for mental health services rises, providers can't break even.  
**Effective:** Late June 2026

### [Johnson Memorial Health Closing Maternity Care Unit](#)

**Where:** Franklin, Indiana — Johnson Memorial Health, Maternity Care Center  
**Impact:** 48 staff laid off  
**Why it matters:** Franklin Memorial is the county's only hospital, so closures brought on by Medicaid cuts mean longer travel, delayed emergency care, and worse outcomes, especially for low-income patients.  
**Effective:** Early June 2026

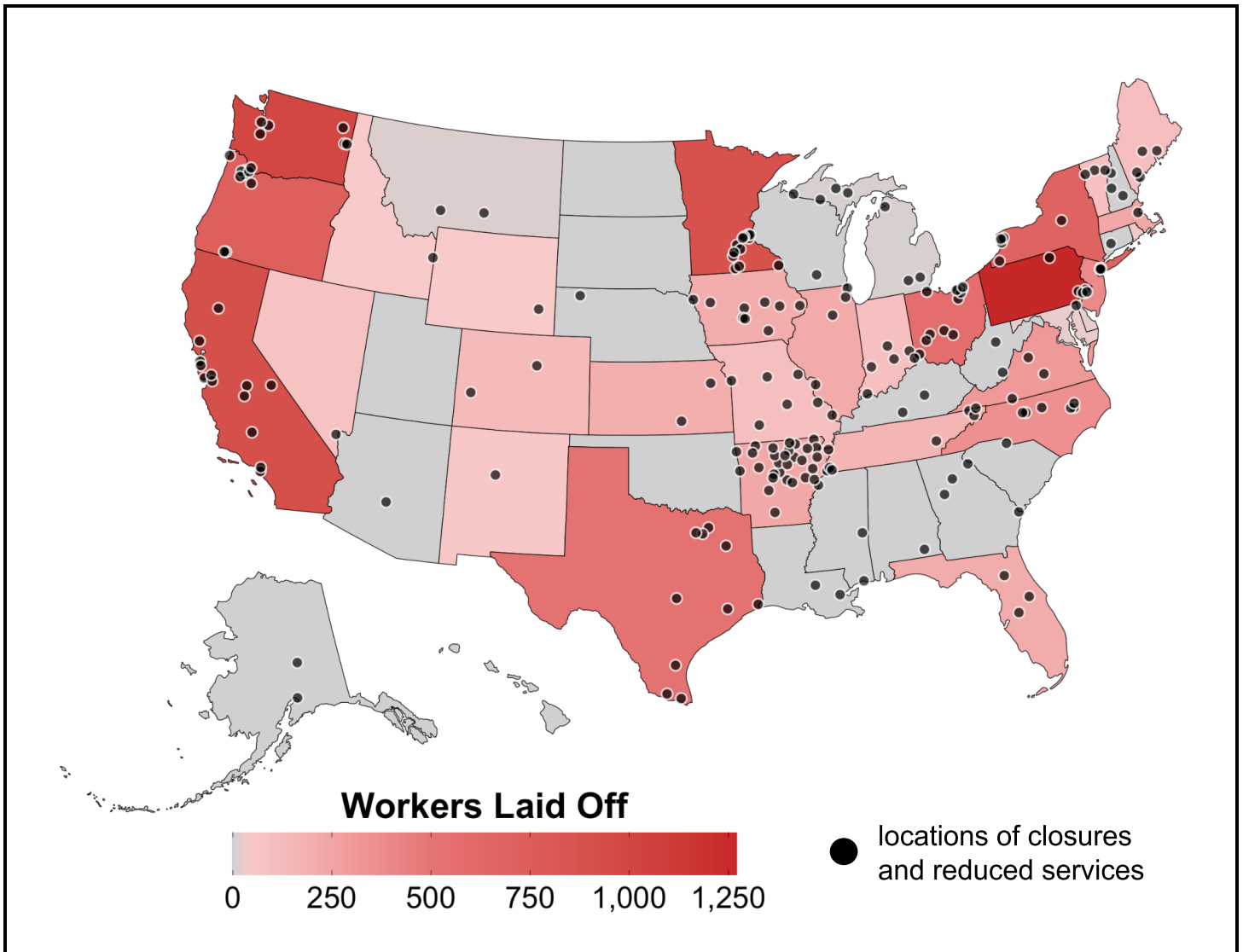
