

Results of Executive Session to Consider Favorably Reporting the Nomination of Steven Terner Mnuchin, of California, to be Secretary of the Treasury and the Nomination of Thomas Price, of Georgia, to be Secretary of Health and Human Services.

Unanimous Consent request to temporarily suspend rule 4, and all applicable rules of the Finance Committee to report out the nominations of Steven Mnuchin to be Secretary of the Treasury and Dr. Thomas Price to be Secretary of Health and Human Services, and that the rules come back into operation after the conclusion of the votes. The Chairman ruled the unanimous consent non-germane. The Chairman then moved to appeal his own ruling. The ruling of the Chair was overturned by roll call vote: 14 Ayes, 0 Nays.
