Dear Senator Grassley:

On November 30, 2018, I signed the Protocol Replacing the North American Free Trade Agreement with the Agreement between the United States of America, the United Mexican States, and Canada. In accordance with section 106(a)(1)(C) of the Bipartisan Congressional Trade Priorities and Accountability Act of 2015, and pursuant to authority delegated to the United States Trade Representative by the President, I am submitting with this letter a description of the changes to existing laws that I consider would be required to bring the United States into compliance with that agreement. The Act provides that this information must be submitted within 60 days after signing an agreement.

I look forward to working with the Congress to implement this important agreement.
