

# TRUMP'S HEALTH CARE HIT LIST

April 2026

On July 4, 2025, congressional Republicans and Trump enacted the largest health care cuts in history, slashing over \$1 trillion from Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Already, hospitals and clinics are closing, workers are being laid off, patients are losing insurance coverage, and states are scrambling to fill budget gaps. New moms, kids, rural communities, people with disabilities, safety-net providers, and working families are feeling the strain. This digest summarizes the ongoing fallout and provides a conservative snapshot of immediate harms to communities nationwide.

## A CLOSER LOOK AT WHO'S PAYING THE PRICE

### [Baptist Health - Fort Smith Cuts Services and Eliminates 150 Jobs](#)

**Where:** Fort Smith, AR — Baptist Health Fort Smith campus and regional clinics  
**Impact:** 150 layoffs and closure of multiple specialty clinics, including labor and delivery  
**Why it matters:** The restructuring reduces access to maternity, specialty and chronic disease care across western Arkansas, forcing patients to travel farther for treatment.  
**Effective:** Started late April 2026; continuing over the next year

### [Franciscan to Close Pediatric Rehabilitation Clinic in Gig Harbor](#)

**Where:** Gig Harbor, WA — Franciscan Pediatric Rehabilitation Clinic  
**Impact:** Closure of a pediatric rehabilitation clinic serving children with disabilities  
**Why it matters:** The closure disrupts access to specialized therapies for children with complex needs, forcing many families to travel farther for care and potentially delaying critical treatments.  
**Effective:** Late April 2026

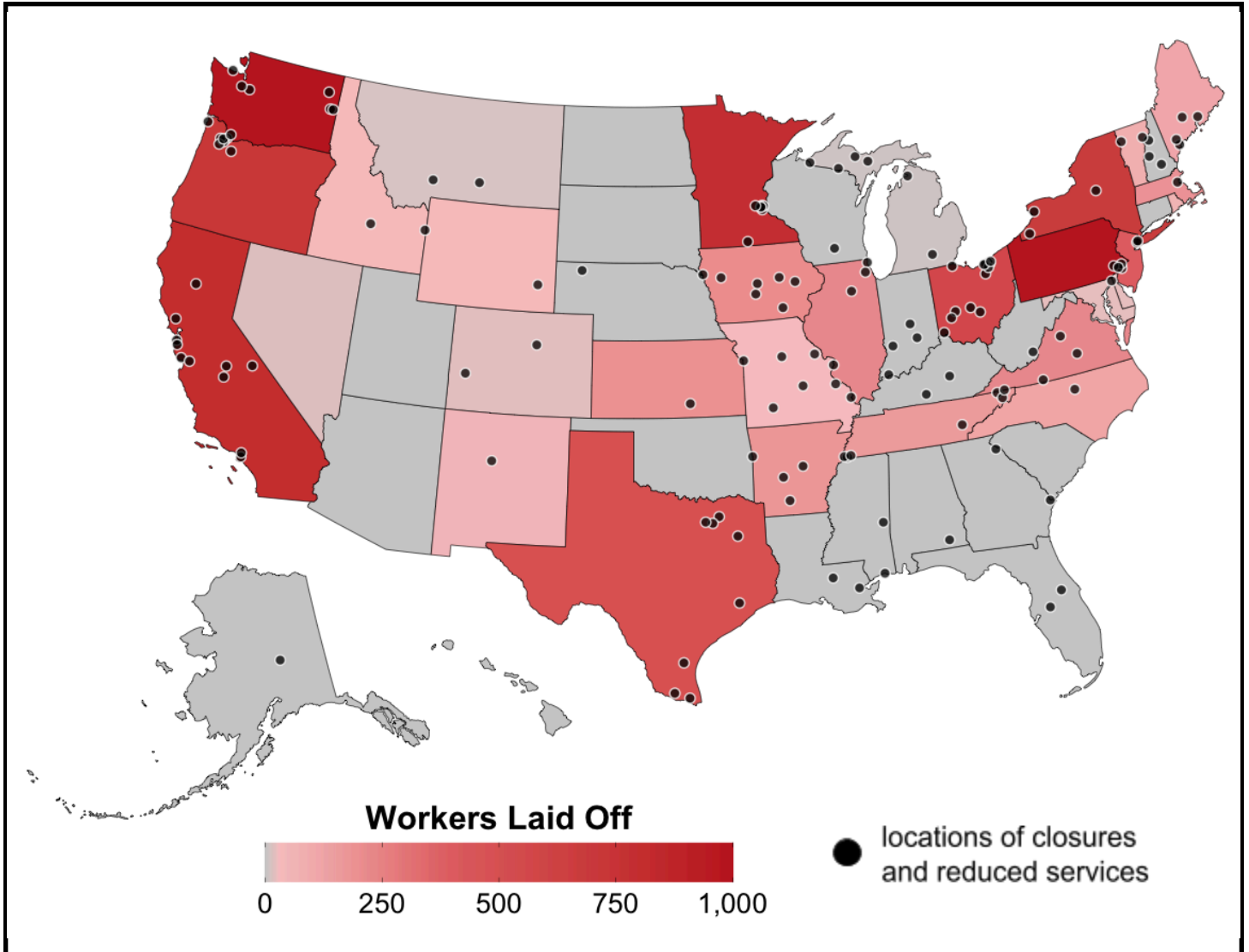
